

Dog Park Rules

FACILITY HOURS:

Anamax Bark Park: 7am-10pm

Quail Creek-Veterans Municipal Park: Sunrise to Sunset

This is a NON-SUPERVISED Facility

Users are responsible for their own safety & actions as well as their pet's.

USE FACILITIES AT YOUR OWN RISK

FOR PEOPLE

- Please be courteous to other users.
- This recreational area is only for off leash dogs **WITH** their owner/handler accompanying them.
- Owners/handlers are responsible for and liable for, the actions of their dogs and any damage to person or property caused by same.
- Owners/handlers **MUST** clean up after their dogs, disposable bags are available in the park.
- You must remove your dog at the **FIRST sign** of aggression.
- Children **12** and younger must be closely supervised by an adult at **ALL TIMES**.
- This facility is for dogs only. No other animals are allowed.
- Please remain inside the enclosed areas in view of your dog at all times.
- You must have your leash in hand at all times for safety.
- Food is not allowed nor drinks in glass containers. No alcohol is permitted.
- Pick up all toys, leashes and other personal items, the Town is not responsible for loss or pick up. (Exception: an approved storage container placed by P & R Department)
- All dogs must be leashed prior to and upon leaving the dog park area. (Town leash law; Chapter 6.15)
- Bikes, skateboards, rollerblades etc. **prohibited**.

FOR DOGS

- **ALL** dogs must be vaccinated and licensed.
- Puppies under 4 months prohibited.
- The dog park area identified for small dogs is for smaller or very passive dogs.
- The dog park area identified for large dogs is for larger and active dogs.
- **LIMIT** of two (2) dogs per handler in each area.
- Female dogs in heat prohibited, spayed/neutered dogs recommended.
- Dogs must be under voice control of owner/handler, (come when called).
- Dogs are not permitted to dig large holes in the turf or other areas of the park causing permanent damage, owners will be responsible for damage and repair.
- **No dog fighting. Call 911.** The authorities should be called to remove the aggressor.
- Visibly or knowingly ill dogs & dogs recovering from surgery prohibited in both areas.
- **Above all, have fun** and play nice with the other dogs and people using the dog park!
